#### **IPAs**

Alpine Lake IPA: Our flagship IPA is loaded with late hop additions and pounds of dry hops to give it lots of flavor without an overpowering bitterness. Strong notes of grapefruit, passion fruit and hints of strawberry make this beer one of our most popular. 12oz: \$7.50 6.2% ABV • IBU 30

Mighty Madison IPA: An old school, classic west coast IPA, this beer has a more assertive hop bitterness with a malty back bone and nice piney finish. Brewed with classic hops like Cascade, Centennial and Columbus to bring out the pine flavor with a slight orange undertone. A bolder brew, just like the little lady it's named after. 6.3% ABV • IBU 60

Hoppy Henry Session IPA: Bursting with tropical flavors, this East Coast IPA is brewed with oats and wheat to give it a nice hazy appearance with a soft mouth feel. A double dry hopped session IPA with pounds of late addition Mosaic, Citra and El Dorado hops to give a ton of flavor with very little bitterness. 5% ABV • IBU 20

Emmy Lou's Brew: A tasty blend of Pacific Sunrise from New Zealand and El Dorado hops from the U.S. create a delicious bouquet of melon, berries and stone fruit. The oats 10oz: \$7.00 Growler: \$20 lend just a touch of haze, while the rice gives it a nice crisp bite. A cheers to the one I am always looking to impress, here's to you Boss Lady. 6% ABV • IBU 60

Hala Kahiki Milkshake IPA: This delicious IPA is brewed with 40 pounds of pineapple puree and tons of New Zealand hops, which bring tropical notes to beautifully complement the pineapple. The addition of lactose offsets the bitterness from the hops, 12oz: \$8.00 making it a truly sweet, tropical treat. 7.2% ABV • IBU 33

#### **Pale Ales**

PMD: The pale morning dun is a timeless western dry fly and we decided to brew a more traditional pale ale to complement its namesake. Dry-hopped with Cascade hops 10oz: \$6 to give it that wonderful northwest flavor of pine and citrus, while caramel malts give it a beautiful golden appearance with a rich flavor, this ale may just become as timeless as the fly after which it is named. 5% ABV • IBU 40

### Wheats, Lagers, Ambers and Kölsh

Hickory Hill Raspberry Wheat: Light and refreshing best describe this beer, it is a perfect treat on a warm summer day. The sweetness of the honey malt balances nicely with the tart raspberry creating a wonderful combination of an easy drinking beer full of 12oz: \$6.50 Growler: \$17 flavor. 4.8% ABV • IBU 12

Leaping Trout Lager: A beautiful American lager brewed with malts from Idaho, yeast from Colorado and paired with some tasty hops from Oregon. This perfect summer beer is light and crisp with a delicious hop flavor and aroma. Pairs best with releasing a Big Trout. 5% ABV • IBU 15

### **Browns & Porters**

North Fork Nut Brown: A complex mix of delicious malts, chocolate, honey, and a toasted nuttiness are the most noticeable flavors in this beer. The light hopping really lets the flavors of the malt come through and will be sure to hook you with its complexity and easy drinking. 5% ABV • IBU 11

Cold Brew Coffee Porter: Our porter has nice tones of toffee and chocolate which play well with the cold brew coffee to give it a robust coffee flavor without the bitterness. We use locally roasted coffee from Moon Frog Coffee. 5.8% ABV • IBU 65

Rick Stout: Named after the local legend himself, Rick Stone, this beer is smooth, rich, and full of flavor. Brewed with lactose and oats to give it that smooth character, we then blend it with delicious cocoa shells from our neighbors at Monarch Lake Chocolate and Coffee Co. for a strong chocolate backbone. A small addition of Warrior hops adds

a nice bitterness to the sweetness of the lactose. Cheers Rick, we miss you.
