<b>Mighty Madison IPA:</b> An old school, classic west coast IPA, this beer has a more assertive hop bitterness with a malty back bone and nice piney finish. Brewed with classic hops like Cascade, Centennial and Columbus to bring out the pine flavor with a slight orange undertone.
