Alpine Lake IPA | 6.2% ABV • 35 IBU

Our flagship IPA, bursting with grapefruit, passion fruit, and strawberry, this smooth IPA packs flavor without the bite.

Tiger Trout IPA | 6% ABV • 77 IBU

Bold and balanced, this hybrid-inspired IPA blends Citra, Mosaic, and El Dorado hops for a citrusy bite that keeps you coming back (just like hunting tiger trout!).

Mighty Madison IPA | 6.3% ABV • 60 IBU

A bold West Coast IPA with pine-forward hops and a malty backbone. Cascade, Centennial, and Columbus deliver classic bitterness with a hint of orange. A bold brew, just like the little lady it's named for.

Hoppy Henry Session IPA | 4.5% ABV • 20 IBU

A hazy, tropical session IPA with a soft mouthfeel and bold hop flavor. Double dry-hopped with Idaho 7 and El Dorado for juicy intensity and minimal bitterness.

Emmy Lou's Brew IPA | 6% ABV • 60 IBU

A bright blend of Pacific Sunrise and El Dorado hops delivers melon, berry, and stone fruit notes. Oats add a soft haze, while rice brings a crisp finish. Brewed in honor of the one I'm always trying to impress — here's to you, Boss Lady.

Amarillo by Morning Pale Ale | 5% ABV • 55 IBU

Amarillo Cryo hops and pilsner malts lead this crisp, citrus-forward pale ale. Red grapefruit, lemon, and orange ride a golden base with a touch of caramel malt.

Hickory Hill Raspberry Wheat | 4.8% ABV • 12 IBU

Light, crisp, and full of flavor. Honey malt sweetness meets tart raspberry for a perfectly refreshing pour.

Dragon Fruit Ale | 4.5% ABV • 10 IBU

Fruity and refreshingly pink. Tropical dragon fruit notes make this an easy sipper with a hint of whimsy.

Catamount Kölsch | 5% ABV • 20 IBU

Easy-drinking and light. Brewed with pilsner and honey malts for a clean finish and gentle hop touch.

El Pescador Mexican Lager | 5% ABV • 10 IBU

Brewed with corn and pilsner malt and Azacca hops to make it light and bright. Served with lime for a splash of beachside escape — or a nod to chasing fish on the flats.

#9 Amber Lager | 5% ABV • 15 IBU

Smooth, full-flavored with a malty finish and just an elbow of hoppy bitterness — a classic, just like Gordie Howe.

Festbier | 5% ABV • 22 IBU

A crisp German lager with rich malt flavor, subtle toastiness, and a clean, dry finish — brewed for celebration.

Angler's Amber | 5% ABV • 25 IBU

Malt-forward and smooth, with caramel and amber malts balanced by soft English hops. Light bitterness and a clean finish make this an easy-drinking classic.

MALTY & RICH

Stouts, browns, and porters with depth and heart

Thunderbird Coffee Porter | 5.8% ABV • 27 IBU

Roasty with notes of toffee, chocolate, and cold brew coffee — all from locally roasted Moon Frog beans. Bold flavor, no bitterness.

This light-drinking dark ale has notes of chocolate, honey, toffee and toasted malts. A dash of English hops lets the complex malt character shine.
